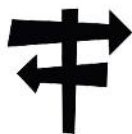

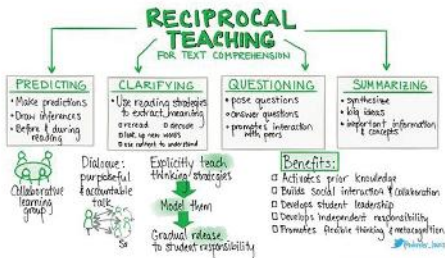

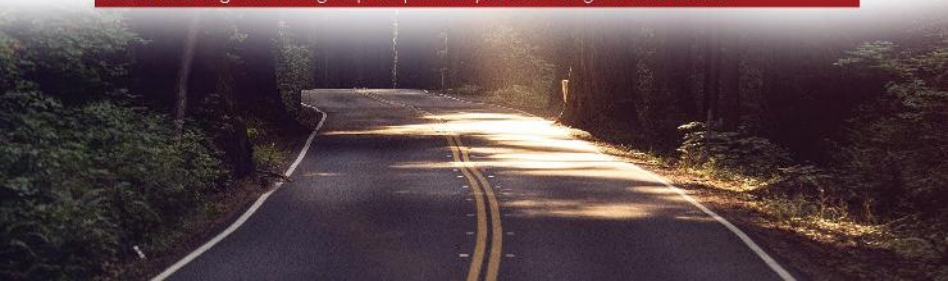
### 1. Awareness.
