



RESEARCH PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

Students applying for the research-based postgraduate programs are required to prepare and submit a research proposal.

Below are the key components of the proposal:

- Field of Research
- Topic of Research
- Background of Research
- Problem statement
- Objective
- Methodology
- Schedule of research work
- Equipment to conduct research (if any)
- Budget details and source of financing (if any)
- Expected outcome the
- Summary / Conclusion

Applicants are advised to ensure the following before submission:

- The proposal must be clear and professional.
- The proposal must be genuine.
- The proposal must be described in detail as mentioned above.
- The research proposal must not exceed 1,500 words or about 2 to 3 pages.

*Applicants who do not meet the minimum English Entry Requirement for a chosen programme are required to attend an Intensive English Programme (IEP) and achieve a required score before starting the Master or PhD programme.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

PROGRAMME

Master by Research

- A Bachelor's degree in a related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.75 out of 4.00, or its equivalent qualifications as accepted by the HEP Senate; OR
- A Bachelor's degree in a related field not meeting the CGPA of 2.75 but above the CGPA of 2.50 out of 4.00, or its equivalent qualifications may be accepted, subject to the HEP's rigorous internal assessment (may include tests, interviews or portfolio); OR • A Bachelor's degree in a related field with CGPA below 2.50 out of 4.00, or its equivalent qualifications
- may be accepted, subject to a minimum of 5 years of working experience in relevant field.
- English Proficiency requirement: IELTS 5.0 6.0. Students whose previous education was in English medium can be exempted from the requirement by providing a Letter of Medium of Instruction.

Master by Coursework Accounting & Information Technology

- A bachelor's degree in a related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.75 as accepted by the HEP senate; OR
- A bachelor's degree in a related field not meeting the CGPA of 2.75 but above CGPA of 2.50 can be accepted, subject to the HEP's rigorous internal assessment; OR
- A bachelor's degree in a related field below a CGPA of 2.50 can be accepted, subject to a min of 5 years of working experience in a relevant field.
- English Proficiency requirement: IELTS 5.0 Students whose previous education was in the English medium can be exempted from the requirement by providing Letter of Medium of Instruction.

Master by Coursework

Mechanical Engineering, Architecture, Creative Industries & Communication

- A Bachelor's Degree in a relevant field or its equivalent, with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 out of 4.00, as accepted by the HEP's Senate; OR
- A Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent, not meeting CGPA of 2.50, can be accepted subject to a minimum of 5 years of working experience in a relevant field.
- Students applying for Master of Architecture are required to have B.Sc (Hons) (Architectural Design) of City U (LAM Part 1) with a minimum CGPA 2.50; and with at least 6 months of work experience after receiving a degree, with a B grade in the final Design course
- English Proficiency requirement: IELTS 5.0-6.00. Students whose previous education was in English medium can be exempted from the requirement by providing a Letter of Medium of Instruction.

Doctorate

- Qualifications equivalent to Master's degree in a relevant field (Level 7, MQF) or as accepted by the HEP Senate.
- English Proficiency requirement: IELTS 6.0. Students whose previous education was in the English medium can be exempted from the requirement by providing a Letter of Medium of Instruction.

Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)


- A Master's Degree, as accepted by the HEP's Senate; OR
- Other qualifications equivalent to a Master's Degree, as accepted by the HEP Senate.
- Please take note that students applying for a PHD in Design or PHD in Performing Arts will be we required • to Pass an interview OR submit a portfolio as determined by the HEP as.
- English Proficiency requirement: IELTS 5.0 6.0. Students whose previous education was in the English medium can be exempted from the requirement by providing a Letter of Medium of Instruction.

* The above entry requirements serve as a general admission guidance. Student acceptance to the programme is subject to faculty assessment and student results meeting his specialization programme requirement.
